Black is a 30-something black FTM living out of his car while struggling to keep his job as a security guard in an upscale apartment complex on Oakland's Jack London Square. He keeps a public confessional on YouTube and dreams of a better life, wanting desperately to join with others who are enjoying the current tech boom that defines the vibrancy of life in the San Francisco Bay Area. Blue is a 40-something black MTF who was once a 1990s tech executive, having transitioned after the dot com boom and bust of early 2000s. She lives a lonely, mysterious life in the building where Black's car is parked and watches him from the window. She has an android/friend-bot named Lison who observes and learns from Blue's life, offering hope and companionship. When Black comes home beaten by a gang of aggressive butches, Blue takes him in and nurses him back to health. She says, "You are just like me. Your secrets are safe here." They become fast friends, sharing secrets from the past and aspirations for the future. One night they make love, and Blue promises to train Black in tech, so he can move forward with his life. With this new relationship, Blue's faith in love is restored, and she needs Lison less and less. Eager to help, Blue uses her tech skills to forge documents for Black that land him an entry level job at an Oakland startup. At work, Black meets Ella, a hot coder who takes Black under her wing, bringing him to queer coder events where he sees possibilities of a new community where he can work and thrive. Ella knows Black is FTM and likes him anyway. One night, they, too, make love. At home, Blue becomes jealous of Black's new circle of friends, and he tries perilously to keep his budding romance with Ella a secret. Lison watches and attempts to help negotiate the conflict, only to find that when betrayal is involved, no human being can be at their best. When lines are crossed and Blue questions Black's integrity, she follows Black out into the streets of Oakland, only to discover that he and Ella are lovers. Caught in a web of deceit and confusion, Blue finds no way out but to kill Black and take her own life. In the end, Lison is the last one left "standing," unable to interpret the violence, wishing for a better way of life for all humans.
